Committee

Team Solent Climbing committee roles include President, Vice President, Treasurer, Social Media Secretary, Social Secretary, and Equipment Officer. Applications will be taken at the end of each year for the positions; depending on the volume of applications there will be a vote. The assignment of new committee members will, however, partially depend on experience in the sport, this is due to the particular nature of climbing as a sport and the safety precautions that come with it.

Finances

Finances are held and monitored by both the Treasurer and President of the club. These must only be used for use on club trips, equipment, and payment to Bouldershack. A record of all transactions must be kept on a spreadsheet on the shared cloud account.

Equity

Any breach of this document will be reviewed by the committee alongside Sport Solent and appropriate action will be taken. This may include being removed from the club.
